Queen Elizabeth II, 1952-date

A 1953 florin (or 'two shillings'). The first coins to feature the Queen were dated 1953. All of the silver coloured coins, like the 28.5mm florin, were given completely new reverse designs. This attractive floral design, representing the countries of the United Kingdom was used on all florins until it was replaced by the decimal 10p in 1968.
